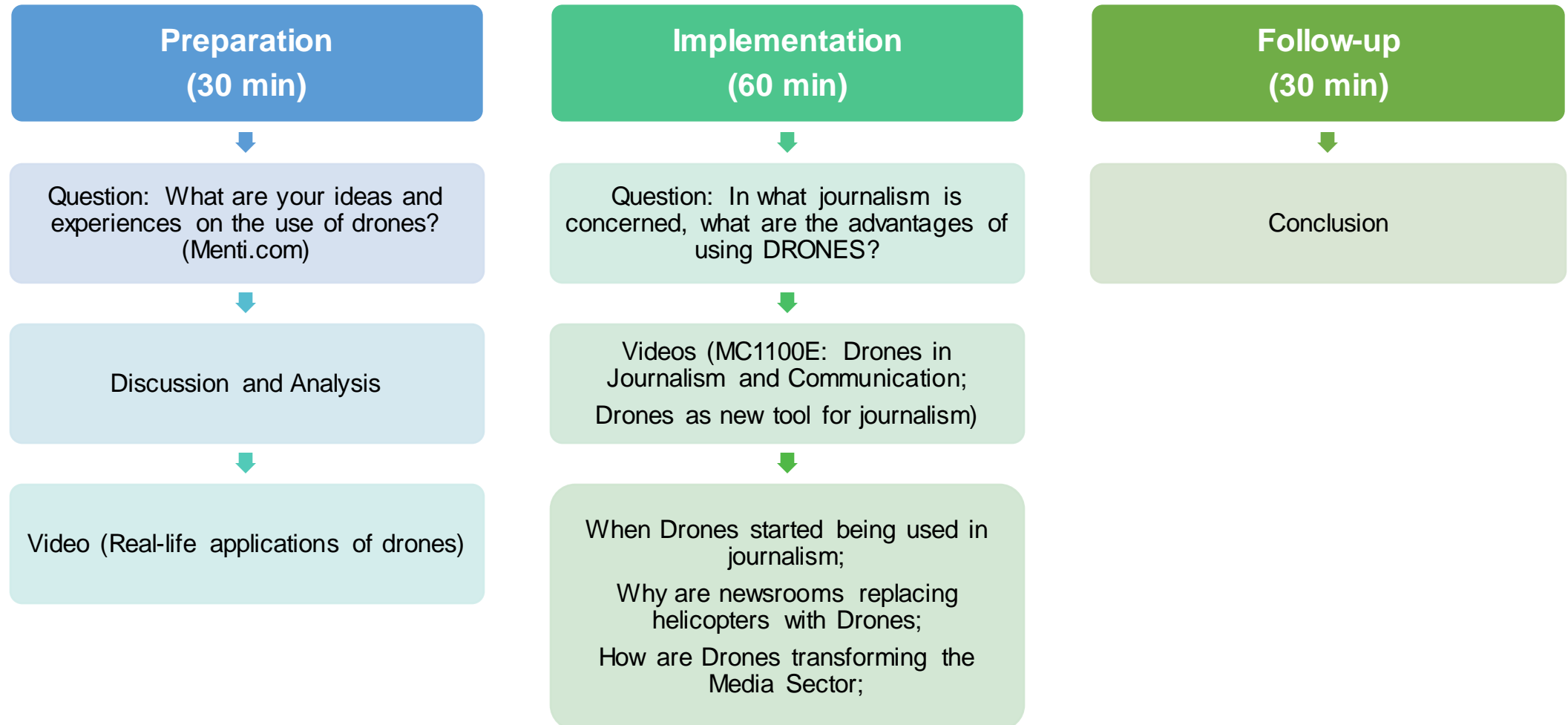

### Aims

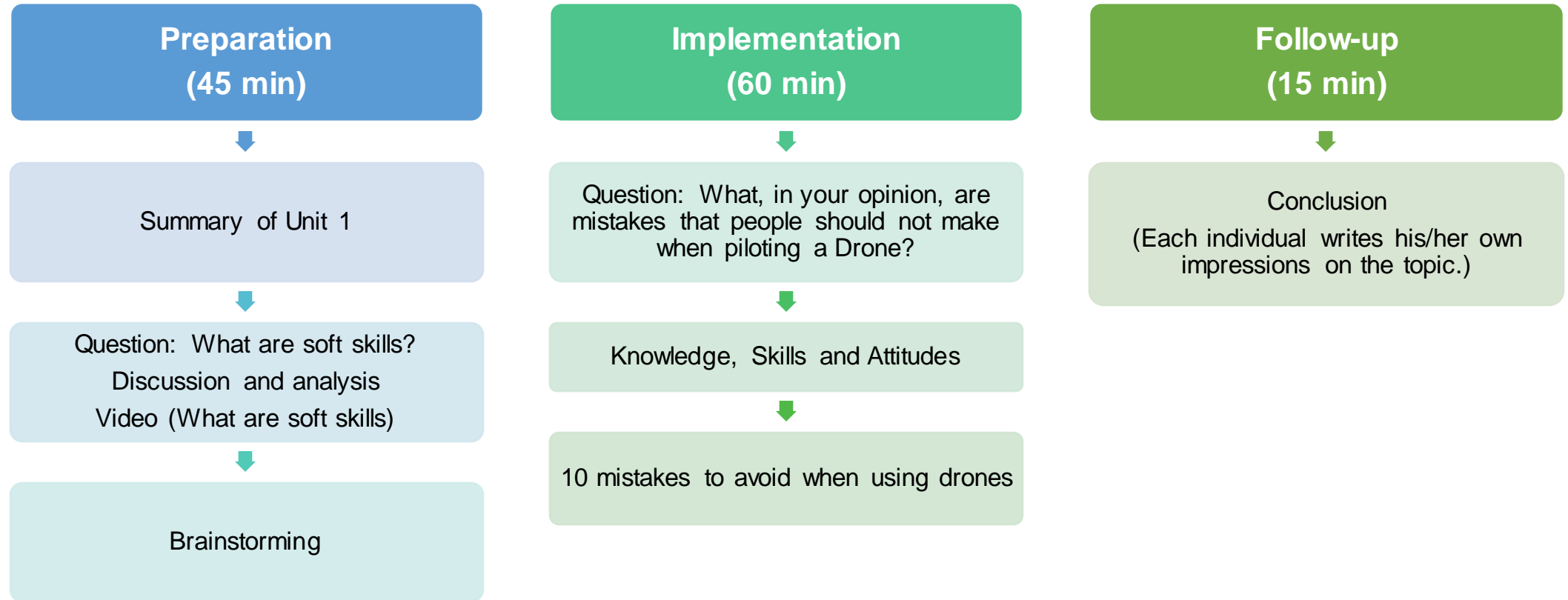
- Understand that to do drone journalism you need to be resilient and it is a constant learning process;
